

- Volume of waste processed by ecosystems




What is human wellbeing?

Human wellbeing is the state of being comfortable, prosperous, healthy, or happy. Objective and subjective


Common measures of human wellbeing


- Gross domestic product (GDP)
- Human Development Index (Life expectancy, Education, GDP)
- Equity (e.g. Gini coefficient)




The paradox

Why is human well-being increasing while ecosystem services degrade?








What we think to be the problem

- Current measures of human wellbeing not sensitive to ecosystem decline
- Policy targets either environmental or developmental
- Existing data are not fit for purpose



Our objective

Transform existing data to develop indicators which reflect a better connection between ecosystem services and human wellbeing





Development Goals targets:

- halve the proportion of people living below the poverty line of \$1.25 and;
- increase employment in ecosystem based sectors to population ratio

Indicators we propose;


Eco based out poverty = \triangle poverty level * $\frac{\triangle E cosystem \ based \ income}{\triangle \ Total \ national \ income}$


 $Ecobased\ employ\ to\ pop\ ratio = \frac{Ecosystem\ employ}{Total\ population}$


Other indicators

GPI, Happiness Index









District health barometer 2012


Opportunities to move up the y-axis



Opportunities to move up the y-axis




Opportunities to move up the x-axis


